

Colleagues at Women & Infants,

We are happy to announce the ability to use COVID antigen testing for patients in the Emergency Department and inpatient units **effective April 2, 2024**. This test is restricted to use for certain patients including:

- Patients with confirmed COVID in last 90 days that are newly symptomatic and have a COVID positive PCR
- "Other Reason"- Requires approval from Infectious Disease Doctor
- Patients needing clearance for NICU Visitation- Requires approval from Infectious Disease Doctor or Infection Preventionist

Of note, this test is time sensitive. The specimen must be sent to lab within 30 minutes of collection. As a result, we are unable to offer this test in ambulatory sites at this time. This is a dry swab, which is different from the PCR swab currently used.
